



- Hardwood sawdust
- Water and a fur cleaner.
- Drumming cleans the pelts and softens the leather
- Value added process
- Fur is drummed before grading process.



- Two step process
- Closed drum filled with sawdust, fur cleaner and water.
- Tumbles in closed drum by rising to the top and falling back to the bottom of the drum.
- Set on a timer.



- Step two
- Shaker side of drum.
- Allows sawdust to fall out of screened open drum.
- Sawdust comes out filthy dirty.
- Pelt come out fluffy and clean.



- The cleaner the pelt going into the drum the better the results coming out of the drum.
- Clean any dirt or blood out of pelt before shipping.



- You can clean your pelts by combing and using borax.
- A dog's slicker brush works best.
- Also use a coarse stone fur comb.
- Sprinkle borax into fur let sit for a few minutes than gently comb out.
- Repeat as needed.
