- A lure is used to trigger a response.

General Rules with Lure & Urine

- Read the description it should explain what it is good for and what it should target.
- Almost any canine lure will attract wolves, coyotes, foxes and cats.
- Different lures trigger different results.
- Don't overuse lure, remember k-9s have an incredible sense of smell.
- Remember to shake well before use.
- Could have be on the shelf for a year or more.
- Most lures use beaver castor and or muskrat glands as main ingredients.
- Be cautious when buying urine, you want the real stuff not something cut with water.

Urine



- Urine is used at set to trigger certain responses.
- Urine can be used for curiosity at a set in combination with a gland lure or a food lure.
- Can be used on its own to trigger a specific action.

Urine

- Can be used on its own in post set
- Can be used on any set as attractor flat sets, dirt holes.
- Coyote or Fox urine is easiest to buy, works just as well on either coyotes or wolves.
- Urine should smell strong with a hint of ammonia.
- Not all urine is equal - should never smell like a sewer.
- Hawbaker's is a good brand.

Food Lure



- Put the lure in the hole, generally by the spoonful
- You want the targeted animal to work the set
- Used with a gland lure and or urine.

Call Lure



- Used on top of set and/or near set to get the animal to stop and investigate the actual set.
- Generally a loud smell - lots of skunk essence.
- Can be used with urine or food lure.

Curiosity Lure



- Normally has a combination of castor, glands and a call lure.
- Triggers the targeted animal to investigate the set.

Scat



SCAT



- Wolf or Coyote scat is a statement
- Used extensively to mark territory.
- Can be used to catch other wolves and or coyotes.
- Tells you what they are eating.

SCAT

- Wolves and Coyotes are opportunistic predators
- Will eat what is available depending on the time of year.
- Always hunting, always on the move
- Dark colour scat is meat
- Check for hair in scat mainly beaver during open water, moose or deer during the winter.
- You can collect scat for use later in the season.

Usage for Scat



- Useful for flat sets
- Just add some urine to freshen it up
- Coyote or fox urine works just as good on wolves as it does on coyotes.
- Remember scent post and scat are pack statements.

Off Season Storage lures & urine

- Keep in a cool dry location away from direct sunlight and too much heat
- Good from year to year if stored properly
- Urine should remain with a bit of a sharp odor with a hint of ammonia.
- Always remember to shake well before use, lure and urine will separate over time and need to be shaken well to mix up ingredient's.
- Can be expensive, use the proper way.
